Kentucky Federation of Square and Round Dancers, Inc. Has Arrived

The Kentucky Federation of Square and Round Dancers, Inc. (KFSD) was officially formed on October 12, 2008. This is a "New" State organization that will coincide with the current Kentuckiana Square and Round Dance Association (KSDA). The structure of KFSD will be drastically different from previous state organizations. Under KFSD, the state will be divided into three distinct regions to better serve the

member clubs throughout Kentucky and our neighboring states. We feel this will promote better club relations and increased visitation between all clubs. The **Blue Spirit Region** will include clubs from Corbin, Harrodsburg, Hazard, Nicholasville, Lexington, London, Mt. Sterling, Paintsville, Somerset, Winchester, Northern Tennessee and Western West Virginia. The **Gold Region** will have member clubs

from Elizabethtown, Louisville, Radcliff, Springfield and southern Indiana. The **XXX Region** will be comprised of clubs from Covington, Northern Kentucky and Southern Ohio.



KFSD State Square and Round Dance Convention Plans

The KFSD will sponsor an annual State Convention beginning in the fall of 2009. For many years one of the major complaints among Kentucky square dance clubs has been that the state convention has always been held in the same geographic location. Under KFSD the location of the state convention will rotate among the three regions. Each region will host the state convention once every three years. The Blue Spirit Region is

proud to announce that we will be hosting the convention in 2009. In 2010, the convention will move to the XXX Region. The Gold Region will host the convention in 2011. The Blue Spirit Region is currently gathering information from various convention facilities capable of hosting the convention in 2009. Among the possible locations being considered are The Centre for Rural Development in Somerset and Heritage Hall (Rupp Arena) in

Lexington. We are also looking into the possibility of getting financial assistance for the state convention through corporate sponsorships. This will allow us to hold the conventions in prime facilities and possibly lower the cost to convention attendees. We want to hear from you if you have any ideas and/or suggestions on how we can better serve all federation dancers and clubs.
