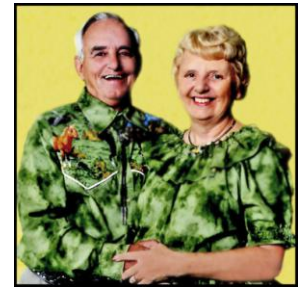

## History of Hardin County Fair Squares



Hardin County Fair Squares Elizabethtown, KY got their start in a garage in Glendale, KY, owned by Wayne and Gladys Cardin, with 13 people. Our first caller was Fred Jackson he called for the club many years. The first Open House was at the Glendale school April 1971 on a Friday, and started its first class at the Fair Grounds in Elizabethtown, KY. The first graduated class was October 15, 1971. The design of the name and badge came from the fact the group danced at the Fair Grounds. In December 1971 the vote was made to change the dance night from Friday to Saturday.

When the old MRC (Memorial Recreation Center) building, located at the corner of Hwy 62 and College Street in Elizabethtown, became available Hardin County Fair Squares moved there for about a year, until it closed and members went back to the Fair Grounds. The building was torn down, and now another building owned by a Rental Implement Equipment Company occupies that site

The Club formed a cooperation August 27, 1977. The first dance was in March 1979, meals were served. Members worked hard toward having their own building at the Fair Grounds, but when the old Skating Rink was obtainable, Hardin County Fair Squares purchased the building from DAV (Disabled American Veterans) in February 1993. This is where we presently dance.

Earlier the club did Round dancing with Betty Jackson cuer. In July 1997 line dance classes were started with Joann Jewell on Tuesday Nights. Benita Clark has been the Treasurer since July 7, 1994. Benita Clark and Marvin Wieman have been members of the club since 1990. Benita has been the Treasurer since 1994.

There were 54 members in January 1994 and it has gradually declined since that time. The club has had different fundraisers to help with the maintenance and supplies, such as raffles, cake walks, yard sales, auctions, craft sales at other county and town festivals, to name a few.

The club also had an annual festival every year, but is unclear as when it actually started and ended. One Festival is noted in October 1988 with the callers: Chuck Myers, Fred Jackson, Jerry Holt and Betty Jackson as the cuer.

Hardin County Fair Squares has had several callers only to mention a few: Fred Jackson, Mac Letson, Jack Bobblele, Larry Davenport, Aaron Morrison, Tony Kincade, Topple McGuffey, Wes Dyer, Bob Braden and also many others as visiting callers. Tony Kincade and Aaron Morrison are currently the callers for the Hardin County Fair Squares. Members and guests do appreciate all the callers and cuers over the years.

In the past and now, it has been said that many folks say, "It is a friendly place to dance." We plan to keep it friendly and keep on dancing! Thanks to all who visit us!

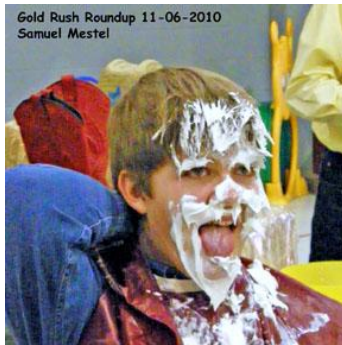
