Meet Deborah Burden



Hi! My name is Deborah Burden. I was born in Fishkill, New York and then moved to New Albany, Indiana when I was a teenager. I graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree with Distinction and Master's Degree in Education from Indiana University Southeast. Activities and awards received include: Early Childhood Trainer Credential, listed in the 9th Edition of "Who's Who Among America's Teachers", and mentor to teachers taking college courses. Having owned and operated Deborah's Daycare and Homeschool for 30 years, the daycare and homeschool were accredited for maintaining the highest standard of quality, and received the 2001 Award for Promoting Excellence in the Childcare Workforce Higher Education Award. Workshops were given in the Family-to-Family Program in Kentucky, ushered at the Kentucky Center for 28 years, also ushered at the Brown Theater, the Palace Theater in Louisville, and the Ogle center in Indiana. I belong to the Holy Family Theatre Group and we put on six shows a year. I have clogged for 20 years, with membership in clogging groups including the Riverside Cloggers, Defever's Cloggers, and Kentuckiana Cloggers. I play bluegrass guitar at the BBC in Louisville. I took lessons with Jeff Guernsey. He was the fiddle player for Vince Gill for a number of years. When I was in college I sang with the Indiana University Southeast Choir and the Holy Family Church Choir.

I fell in love with square dancing when I was introduced to it in gym class in high school. At that time there wasn't any square dancing groups for teenagers. Since that time square dancing has held a special place in my heart. I want to share my love of square dancing with others. At this time I am teaching 240 students at Holy Family School in New Albany. I have about 2 or 3 squares per class. The students are enjoying their lessons. I hope to continue lessons with the students who are interested. I will keep you posted about how that is progressing. These students may be out future square dancers.

I took square dance lessons when I was in my 20's. I did it for years then life got in the way and I quit for a while, but then came back to it. I belong to the Sunnyside Solo's Square Dance Club. I was a member of this club when it started in 1982.

When I was taking Calling lessons from Wes in September 2010, he asked each of us what our goal was. I said, "I want to teach children to square dance." As a teacher I enjoy working with children. I approached the principal of Holy Family School in New Albany, Indiana, about teaching the students to square dance. I gave him a copy of the Callerslab Basic and Mainstream teaching list and lessons plans for each class. He liked the idea and we made plans for a school exhibition in October. We had over 450 students and faculty to watch the square dancers. Then the students came onto the floor to try it. We had 5 squares of students. I taught them some basic moves; putting it to patten then to a song. They enjoyed it. The Tribune came and put it in the newspaper. I plan on sending notes home to see if any of the students would be interested in continuing square dance lessons. I hope some of the faculty and parents might want lessons. Square dancing is an excellent tool to teach listening skills, following direction, making friends, and discipline. We may have some future square dancers in this group. I hope to plant the seed of enjoying square dancing when they are young and as they become older they will remember how fun square dancing was. I would love to see the population of square dancers increase. If children grow up with square dancing they may want to continue dancing when they are older. It is like planting a seed and watching it grow.

I love Calling and square dancing. I have met many new friends. I am available for parties, church functions, exhibitions, school assemblies, and teaching square dancing to people who want to learn. I have taught people at parties. I did St. Matthew's Episcopal Church Picnic Exhibition, Holy Family School Assembly, a Hoedown at St. Mary's of the Knobs Church, and a 50's dance at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. I enjoy Calling at the different clubs. It means a lot to me when I see square dancers having a good time when I Call.

I would like to thank everyone for their support - to the Callers who are helping me be a good Caller, to the Callers and square dancers who let me call at their clubs, to the square dancers who helped at the exhibitions, and to Wes for teaching me to be a Caller. I would like to thank my mother, Jane, who said, "If you want to Call, go for it." She use to square dance but doesn't anymore. She loves watching it. You have probably seen her at your club a time or two.

I enjoy performing songs that I can use props with. I am getting a lot of practice working with the students.

History of Kentuckiana Squares Dance Club

Kentuckiana Squares was started as the Rotators Singles Square Dance Club in 1972. The first By-laws were dated Aug 2, 1972 and the first President was Weylmer Hardin.


The name was changed to Kentuckiana Singles Square Dance Club seven months later effective March 21, 1973. The Singles hosted the Singles Nationals in 1992. The name was changed again May 21, 2009 to Kentuckiana Squares Square Dance Club because they had several married couples. Now they are a singles and couples club where everyone is always welcome.

The callers have been Jack Bybee, Tommy Brady, Charlie Wheatley and Phil Robinson. Charlie Wheatley resigned in 1985 and Phil started calling at that time. The cuers for rounds were Dorothy Sanders and Betty Boyd. Dorothy Sanders resigned in 1992. Betty has been Cuing and Lines since 1992.
