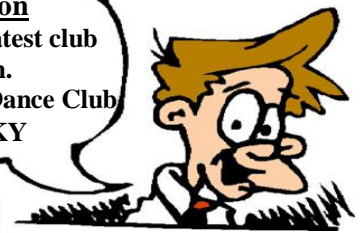

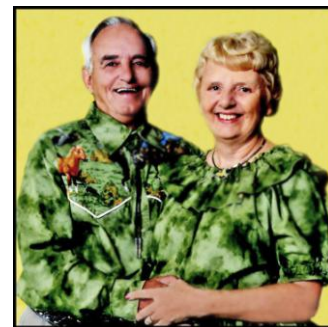

### Meet Samuel Mestel



My name is Samuel Mestel, and I am a 15 year old square dance caller. I started about 5 years ago, when I was halfway through square dance lessons. The caller who was teaching (Tony Kincade)



noticed that I was singing along with him as he called, and not just the song, but the calls as well. One night after lessons, he told me he had seen me singing along with him, and was wondering if I wanted to try it out. I thought it might be fun, so he gave me a couple of records to start out with. We borrowed a little Fisher-Price record player (which was so quiet I almost had to practice in a whisper) and on that I practiced my first song, Take Me Out To The Ball Game. The first time I called, nobody got back to their partner, and I forgot to sing a large section of the song....BUT I HAD CALLED FOR MY FIRST TIME!!

Many callers have encouraged and helped me along the way. Tony Kincade started me out and continues to help me. I also took a caller class with Wes Dyer. Along the way, a lot of other callers have encouraged me and given me a chance to call at their dances. I am indebted to all these callers and the dancers who have been good to me. I once told dad that square dancers are some of the nicest people I know, and that is still true. I am now the regular club caller for the Southern Stars, a club near Cincinnati that is youth run but open to dancers of all ages. They dance once a month, and I normally get at least one to two other dances per month as a guest caller as well.

Being homeschooled gives me some flexibility to travel to clubs. As I am not yet able to drive (unfortunately!), my parents are my taxi service! My other interests include playing the piano & violin and I used to play the dulcimer with the Louisville Dulcimer Society. I am an avid reader and like computers. 


